
DISCOVERY LAB

Our diverse and hardworking team of staff and international teachers are ready to share our years of international school experience (in both NY, USA and Tokyo, Japan) and a wealth of knowledge with you all!

It is our goal now to help introduce our unique take on the summer camp adventure concept, as is common in the USA, to Japan, in an international school arena that is hungry for new and innovative learning methods!

MEETING POINT & TRANSPORTATION

Camp participants will gather at lvy Prep International School on the morning of the first day of their adventure! They will then proceed via our school bus service to the camp location, within an hour of central Tokyo.

STAFF & TEACHERS

The children will be accompanied to the camp location by the Van driver, and teachers to maintain a student: teacher ratio of around 1:3.

FOOD

The school kitchen will prepare and supply healthy meals and snacks according to seasonal availability.

HEALTH/MEDICAL

Families must submit the medical information of their participating children for screening prior to their child attending a program. A child may be deemed unable to attend a program on medical grounds if their health and medical information indicates that they might be put at risk.

REQUIRED ITEMS

- Water Bottle
- Facemask (optional)
- Backpack (preferably a hiking type) or duffel bag to carry all personal items
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Bath Towel
- Waterproof Outdoor Jacket
- Hiking boots or tough sneakers
- 2+ pairs of Socks
- Sandals ov flip flops
- Hat, sunscreen
- T-shirts
- Shorts
- Long pants
- Long sleeve T-shirt
- Spare pairs of underwear (enough for each night)
- Pajamas

(We ask that all of our students come well prepared for the challenges of nature and the outdoors. As it is summer, clothing and equipment appropriate for warm weather and ease of movement is recommended.)
